THE WOMAN AT THE WELL

John 4:1-26

Look at these two pictures. They may look the same, but there are five things different in the second picture. Circle the differences.



Jesus met a woman at a well. He asked her for a drink of water. She was surprised when he told her all about life. She had never seen him before but he knew all about her. The woman ran back to town shouting that she had met the Messiah.
